Community Supported Agriculture (CSA) is new relationship between farmers and the folks who eat their produce. CSA members sign up in the spring to receive a 'basket' of organic, farm-fresh produce every week during the growing season (June - October). By paying in advance, CSA members help farmers afford early-season costs such as seeds and other field materials. CSA members accept to share the risks and benefits that come with the vagaries of the growing season. We commit to providing diverse, seasonal baskets of our exceptionally fresh, local produce. Join us for our 6<sup>th</sup> season in 2010!

### Basket Size

**Weekly baskets** provide enough vegetables for a family of 3-4, or a couple that eat a lot of vegetables.

**Bi-weekly baskets** are the same size but delivered every two weeks

Each basket contains 9-12 vegetables grown on our farm, including:

**Leafy greens:** lettuce, chard, kale, arugula, mesclun salads

**Roots:** carrots, beets, turnips, radishes, potatoes, onions, garlic, leeks

**Herbs:** basil, dill, cilantro, parsley, & others

**And more:** tomatoes, peppers, eggplants, zucchini, cucumbers, squash, beans, peas, broccoli, cabbage, kohlrabi, brussel sprouts ...

The contents of the baskets will change with the season. All vegetables are certified organic by Ecocert Canada.

### Drop Off Locations and Times

Members choose one drop-off point for the season from which to collect their vegetables.

- **Tourne-Sol Farm**  
(1025 ch. St-Dominique, les Cèdres)  
on Thursdays from 4PM to 7PM, or
- **Beaurepaire United Church**  
(25 Fieldfare Rd, Beaconsfield)  
on Tuesdays from 5PM to 7 PM

Drop offs start the week of June 14<sup>th</sup> and finish the week of October 11<sup>th</sup>. Bi-weekly members may start one week later. We will contact you in the spring to confirm the start-date.

**IMPORTANT!** If you cannot pick up your basket at the drop off, you can send someone in your place, or you can pick up your missed basket at the farm the following day from 12PM to 7PM. After that, uncollected baskets will be donated. Please note: **We cannot replace or reschedule baskets missed due to vacations.**

### To Register

Please complete the registration form and mail it to the farm with your payment.

Returning members from 2009 can reserve their place by renewing during **the pre-registration period, from October 1st to December 1<sup>st</sup>**. Payment in full before December 1st 2009 entitles you to a \$10 gift certificate, redeemable for our farm's products (flowers, seeds, vegetables) at drop-offs or markets.

**The regular registration period will begin March 1st 2010.** At this point we will accept new and renewing members on a first-come, first-served basis.
